Recall #: CAN152 | 152 - Remedy Notice - Certain 2004-2006 model year Avalon, Camry, Solara, Highlander, Highlander HV, Sienna vehicles - 1MZ-FE/3MZ-FE V6 Engine Crankshaft Pulley Recall Date: 2011 Nov 09

Recall Description

For the subject vehicles equipped with the 1MZ-FE or 3MZ-FE V6 engine, the amount of the adhesive agent applied between the outer ring and the torsional rubber damper (inner ring) in the crankshaft pulley may be inadequate. If the adhesive is insufficient, there is a possibility that the outer ring may become misaligned and it may not properly rotate with the inner ring, causing noise and/or illumination of the discharge warning light. In some cases, the belt for the power steering pump may become detached from the pulley which could result in a sudden increase in steering effort. A sudden increase in steering effort could increase the risk of a crash, causing serious personal injury.

Remedy

Any Toyota dealer will inspect the crankshaft pulley, and, where necessary, replace the crankshaft pulley. In addition, in the event the crankshaft pulley is found to have separated or loosened, Toyota will replace other affected parts associated with and due to this specific condition.

Recall #: CAN220 | 220 - Remedy Notice - Certain 2004-2005 and 2007-2009 model year Sienna vehicles - Shift Lock Solenoid Assembly Recall Date: 2013 Sep 26

Recall Description

The subject vehicles are equipped with a shift lever assembly which contains a shift interlock system. One of the components of the interlock system is a shift lock

solenoid to prevent the shift lever from moving out of P position unless the ignition is ON and the brake pedal is depressed. Due to manufacturing issues, there is a possibility that the solenoid could be damaged and the shift lever could be moved out of P position without depressing the brake pedal. This could result in a vehicle roll away, which could cause a crash.

Remedy

Any Toyota dealer will replace the shift lock solenoid assembly in the subject vehicle.

Recall #: CAN243 | 243 - Remedy Notice - Certain 2004-2011 Model Year Sienna vehicles. Sienna Spare Tire Cable Assembly Recall Date: 2014 May 22

Recall Description

The 2004 through 2011 model year Sienna 2WD vehicles equipped with a spare tire carrier stowed under the vehicle have a light-weight, foam water splash protector installed in front of the spare tire carrier. Due to variation in the placement of the splash protector during normal usage, water splashed rearward with high concentrations of road salt can reach the spare tire carrier and corrode the spare tire carrier assembly cable. If the vehicle is operated in cold climate regions where road salt is frequently used, in an extreme case, the cable may break due to excessive corrosion and the spare tire may separate from the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

Remedy

Toyota will inspect and, if necessary, replace the entire Spare Tire Carrier assembly with an improved carrier
